


Modeled after the pistol carried by the United States Marine detachment assigned to U.S. Special Operations Command, it also wears the new KimPro II™ Dark Earth finish. Outfitted with an integral Tactical Rail for light mounting, G-10 Tactical Grips, bumped and grooved beavertail grip safety, Tactical Wedge Tritium low profile night sights and lanyard loop, it is ideal for home defense or carry.


Both the Grand Raptor II™ and Ultra Raptor II™ .45 ACP pistols from the Custom Shop (pages 6 & 24) combine unequaled Kimber dependability and performance with aggressive surface treatments.

Lizard-scale slide serrations, flat top slides with a single back-cut feathered row of large scales plus feathered frontstraps and logo grip panels set them apart. The Grand Raptor II is suited for competition or carry and the Ultra Raptor II is small, light and perfect for concealed carry. Standard features include night sights.

The limited edition Target Match™ .45 ACP combines traditional and custom features. Stainless steel barrel and barrel bushing, chamber and trigger are all match grade. The frontstrap has a high relief cut under the trigger guard for better control during rapid fire. Wide slide serrations add function and elegance.

Four Kimber .45 ACP pistols will be offered with Crimson Trace® Lasergrips®, including the new Pro TLE II™ (LG). Activated by normal grip pressure, an unobtrusive laser mounted in a grip panel projects a bright red dot on the target, ensuring point of aim. These special gray and black grips with Kimber logo are also available on the Custom TLE II™ (LG), Stainless Pro Carry II™ (LG) and Ultra Carry II/Night Sights™ (LG).

The KPD – Kimber Pro Defense – .40 is an affordable, no-nonsense pistol that is a marvel of simple and safe operation. Ideal for law enforcement, concealed carry or home defense,

the KPD™ is light, easily maintained, tough and absolutely dependable. Equally important, it is thin, and with included interchangeable backstraps the KPD can be instantly fit to even small hands so it points naturally and instinctively. In addition to point-and-shoot simplicity that makes training easy, the KPD is safe to carry and store. Operating safeties are all internal, allowing the pistol to fire only if the trigger is pulled completely through the travel path. Safe storage is ensured by an internal lock as well as a magazine disconnect safety (U.S. Patent No. 6,952,895). An integral Picatinny rail permits light mounting. Like all Kimber pistols, the KPD is manufactured entirely in America.


It has been a generation since Kimber made hunting rifles in standard calibers, but they are back in a big way. Three versions of the Model 8400 are now available in .25-06 Rem., .270 Win., .30-06 Spfd., .300 Win. Mag. and .338 Win. Mag., and limited production runs of additional standard and magnum calibers are planned throughout the year. Like all Kimber rifles they feature match grade barrels, chambers and triggers, pillar bedding, free-floated barrels, Mauser claw extractors and three-position wing safety levers (U.S. Patent No. 6,886,285). They are also lightweight, properly balanced and classically designed in every respect.

Classic Select Grade™ Model 84M™ and Model 8400™ WSM rifles are available in most calibers and present discriminating riflemen with the opportunity to upgrade the quality of their wood stocks. Two versions are offered; A-grade French walnut with greater contrast and broad figure, and AA-grade claro walnut for those who prefer tight, delicate grain. Select Grade rifles have the same stock shape and checkering pattern as Classic models, and the A-grade French walnut version also has an ebony forend tip. All Select Grade rifles wear a special mark on the floorplate. Delivery is expected to fluctuate due to availability of suitable wood.

The KimPro™ Tac-Mag is the ultimate 1911 .45 ACP magazine. Features include three interchangeable floorplates, stainless steel body and Rocket Wire springs with dramatically increased lift. Details on page 63.



Marias™ over & under shotguns are true seven-pin sidelocks like best grade guns from the storied English houses. Hand-finished and scroll engraved to 50% coverage, they feature a bone charcoal case colored receiver, Belgian rust blued barrels and thin wall choke tubes. Initially available in 20 gauge with 12 gauge soon to follow, two grades are offered. The Marias Grade I features grade three Turkish walnut and a semi-pistol grip stock. Grade II models wear grade four Turkish walnut and offer a choice of semi-pistol grip or straight grip stock. Standard features include 3-inch chambers, ejectors and a selection of common barrel lengths. Also, Valier™ SXS shotguns are now available in 16 gauge and with bone charcoal case coloring. The KimPro™ Tac-Mag™ is the ultimate 1911 .45 ACP magazine, and not just for Kimber pistols. They work with almost any brand of mil-spec 1911. Both seven and eight-round versions are available for full-size frames, and a seven-round model is available for shorter frames like the Kimber Ultra Carry. KimPro Tac-Mags feature an exclusive quick change floorplate that allows the immediate attachment of any one of three included bases – stainless steel, slim bumper pad for carry or thick bumper pad for competition or use with extended magazine wells. Built for exceptional performance, Rocket Wire springs give them 25% greater endurance limits than conventional springs.

The Ultra CDP II .45 ACP is short, light and absolutely dependable. It is the finest full-power concealed carry pistol available today.



Kimber 1911 barrels are carefully machined with match grade dimensions to ensure accuracy, and they are also one piece for superior strength. Barrel bushings on centerfires are also match grade, and all are machined from stainless steel blanks.

Chambers are cut to exacting match grade dimensions and then carefully finished for flawless feeding and extraction. Ejection ports are lowered and flared so ejecting brass clears easily. Everything is done inside the Kimber factory.

Kimber pistols have factory tuned match grade trigger groups that break crisp and clean. Slide and magazine releases are slightly extended for quick location and easy operation. Frame has a high kidney cut for best grip position.

Custom quality. Production price.



Slides and frames are mated in the early stages of production and travel through the balance together, ensuring optimum fitting of every part.



The Custom TLE II .45 ACP is identical to the pistol selected by LAPD™ SWAT for duty carry. Features include night sights and 30 LPI frontstrap checkering.

Today, the Kimber Custom sets the standard for all production 1911 pistols. Models are offered with fixed, adjustable or night sights. Some have the Kimber Tactical Rail™ for accessory mounting. Many have slides and frames machined from stainless steel. Others are finished in traditional polished blue or the premium KimPro II™ finish that is self-lubricating and shuts out the elements. Chamberings range from 9mm and the flat-shooting 38 Super to powerhouses like .40 and 10mm. Naturally, most are chambered in the cartridge the 1911 was designed to fire, the great .45 ACP.

As with all Kimber pistols, standard features set Customs apart from other brands. Barrels, barrel bushings, chambers and triggers are all machined to match grade dimensions. Ejection ports are lowered and flared. Sights are mounted in dovetails machined into the slide. Thumb safeties are extended. Highride beavertail grip safeties also have a memory bump.

Kimber Customs are made the right way and from start to finish in the Kimber factory here in America. There is no other way to ensure such a high level of quality.

The Gold Match II™ and Stainless Gold Match II™ are the finest production pistols offered by Kimber. Sharing many features with the Custom family, they also have a stainless steel match grade barrel that is machined oversized and fitted by hand in the Custom Shop for accuracy. Grip panels are shaped from fine rosewood, and then checkered by hand in the classic double diamond pattern. Kimber's adjustable sight with positive and responsive steel-on-steel click adjustment dials is dovetail-mounted into the slide. With a low profile, beveled corners and edges, and serrated blade, it works just as well for concealed carry as it does at the range. The level of finish is outstanding, with all flat surfaces carefully polished to a high shine in contrast to the satin finish on the curves. Both versions are available in .45 ACP, and the Stainless Gold Match II is also available in .40. Additional features include ambidextrous thumb safety and Premium Aluminum Trigger tuned to 3.5 – 4 pounds without creep or overtravel.

The Team Match II .45 ACP is identical to the pistol used by the U.S.A. Shooting Rapid Fire Pistol Team. While they shoot Olympic competition with rimfire pistols, they hone their edge by shooting the action circuit with America's fastest guns. They play to win, and came to Kimber when they needed pistols. To support the Team, Kimber agreed to donate \$100 from the sale of each Team Match II pistol. To date, Kimber has contributed \$400,000 and is now the largest donor of any firearm company in Team history. Unique features of this pistol include red, white and blue U.S.A. Shooting Team logo grips.

The 1911 is the finest defense pistol ever brought to market. Beyond its legendary power and dependability, a 1911 is safe, fast into action and flat enough to tuck under a belt or ride well in a holster. Models with shorter barrels and shorter, lighter frames are some of the most popular concealed carry pistols available today.

Kimber Pro Carry pistols feature a 4-inch match grade bull barrel that fits directly to the slide without a bushing. One inch shorter than a full-size 1911, they are every bit as dependable but easier to conceal. Pro Carry pistols are available with steel, stainless steel or lightweight aluminum frames that reduce overall weight by seven ounces. Kimber aluminum frames are machined from solid blocks of 7075-T7 aluminum to the same critical dimensions as the steel frames. They have been tested to over 20,000 rounds without evidence of meaningful wear.

The Compact Stainless II .45 ACP goes a step further. Both the barrel and frame are shorter than a full-size 1911. With a stainless steel slide and frame, this pistol is rugged and easier to control during rapid fire.

Pro Carry pistols are available with a wide variety of features like night sights, Crimson Trace® Lasergrrips®, tactical rail and frontstrap checkering. Most are chambered in .45 ACP, but 9mm, 38 Super and .40 are also available.


Kimber is the world leader in 1911 quality, and nowhere is this quality more evident or important than in a carry pistol. Kimber Ultra Carry pistols weigh just 25 ounces. Their short 3-inch barrels, compact grips and flat 1911 profiles make them easy to carry and conceal. At the same time, their 7-round magazines pack more power than just about any caliber of revolver.

Dependability is everything in a carry pistol. Each Kimber Ultra Carry has a lowered and flared ejection port with an extra bevel at the front to clear ejecting brass. The match grade bushingless bull barrel is fitted directly to the slide, and a double-wound recoil spring system makes proper operation possible even for a novice. With separate thumb and grip safeties the 1911 design is known for its integrity, and the Kimber Series II™ Firing Pin Safety makes the Ultra Carry even more secure without impeding performance or altering trigger pull. Additionally, the Loaded Chamber Indicator Port™ permits a quick visual check of the chamber.

All Ultra Carry pistols have a carefully machined 7075-T7 aluminum frame. Made on the same state-of-the-art machines and to the same tight tolerances as Kimber steel and stainless steel frames, they are incredibly strong. As proof, Kimber aluminum frames have been tested to over 20,000 rounds with no evidence of meaningful wear. Slides are either steel or stainless steel, depending on model.

The Ultra Carry II™ .45 ACP features a matte black finish and fixed low profile sights. Another version is available with fixed three dot (green) night sights. The Stainless Ultra Carry II™ features a satin-finished stainless steel slide and is available in either .45 ACP or .40. As with the Ultra Carry II, a model with night sights is also offered.

The Ultra Carry II / Night Sights™ .45 ACP is also available with a set of two-tone Crimson Trace® Lasergrips® with the Kimber logo. Extremely effective for self defense, a red dot is projected by simply gripping the pistol.

Kimber Ultra Carry pistols all have standard Kimber features like match grade trigger, beveled magazine well, extended thumb safety, bumped beavertail grip safety, slightly extended slide release and checkered flat mainspring housing. For concealed carry, nothing beats a 1911, and the Kimber Ultra Carry is the finest concealed carry 1911 money can buy. If you carry, carry the best.







machined into the slide, rounded and blended edges. In fact, the only difference between these pistols and the single stack Kimber pistols is the frame. The tops are virtually interchangeable.

Shooters are always surprised when they pick up a Ten pistol for the first time. Most high capacity pistols handle like a brick, even those for smaller calibers. Kimber designed this pistol the right way, and the frame has dimensions almost identical to the classic 1911. Even shooters with small hands can get a proper grip.



Point and shoot.

Discussion about the important features that make up a great defensive pistol often leads to spirited debate. Concealed carry folks talk light weight, power, and rounded edges that do not snag. The home defense segment thinks first, last and always about safety. For them, the perfect pistol is exceptionally safe to store and cannot be fired without following proper procedures known only to approved users. Those who carry within military service or law enforcement duty cite dependability regardless of conditions or circumstance. Generally speaking, all groups believe that learning to operate and fire the pistol must be easy. It should also fit the hand likely to hold it – large or small. Bonus points if it is affordable, and even more if it is made in America.

The Kimber Pro Defense – KPD for short – is just what the name implies, an all-new pistol designed specifically for duty, concealed carry or home defense. Operation is as simple as point and shoot. Equally important, the KPD™ is dependable, ambidextrous and powerful.

With a series of simple and effective safety features incorporated into both packaging and design, the KPD can be quickly and safely stored for minutes or months. Every KPD is shipped in a lockable high-impact storage case. Like all Kimber pistols, the KPD is also shipped with a California-approved cable lock.

KPD pistols have a permanent but unobtrusive integral locking system that prevents the pistol from firing with the turn of a key. Additionally, a magazine disconnect safety that prevents the pistol from firing unless a magazine is inserted is a standard feature. Safe carry is greatly enhanced by a prominent loaded chamber indicator button integrated into the top of the slide. If a round is chambered the button protrudes enough to see at a glance, and in low light conditions it is also easy to feel with a fingertip. A final firing pin block safety prevents accidental discharge if the pistol is dropped.

The double action only (DAO) KPD trigger has a consistent and smooth 8-9 pound pull through its full-length of travel. The quality of the trigger pull enhances accurate shooting while the length of travel greatly reduces the chance of unintentionally firing the pistol in a stressful situation.

When comparing the KPD with other pistols, one of the most striking differences is that it fits the hand and points naturally. With a trim frame width of just 1.08 inches combined one of the three included interchangeable textured backstraps, the KPD can be custom fit in moments to almost any hand. Interchangeable backstraps also allow the pistol to be comfortably used by more than one person. The frame design even positions the trigger finger above the trigger as an additional safety feature.

The KPD frame is properly textured to enhance performance and control. Gripping surfaces feature heavier texturing while other areas use a lighter pattern that does not reflect light. Details continue on the following pages.

The swept grip angle allows a very high gripping position, placing the hand in close alignment with the barrel for increased control and reduced muzzle flip for fast follow up shots and reduced felt recoil.



Three quickly interchangeable textured backstraps that adapt the KPD grip to fit just about any size hand are included with each pistol.



KPD pistols weigh just 25 ounces with an empty magazine. Equally important, they are narrow and fit the hand much better than other modern semi-autos.

Each KPD pistol is packaged with two 12-round magazines for the powerful .40 cartridge, giving each pistol a 13-round capacity when fully loaded. Where required by applicable law, 10-round magazines are substituted. A KPD chambered in 9mm will soon be available.

One of the most important features of the KPD pistol is the integral Picatinny accessory rail that permits the positive and quick attachment of accessories such as a tactical flashlight or laser aiming device. With standard dimensions, this rail fits almost all popular accessory items. Like other parts of the KPD pistol, the corners and edges of the rail are blended so they do not snag or cut.

Light weight makes a pistol easier to carry all day, every day, and the KPD weighs just 25 ounces with an empty magazine inserted. The thin profile also gives the KPD a big advantage over other semi-auto pistols – especially when carried concealed in a belt holster.

Sometimes, the best measure of quality is found in the little things. KPD sights are metal – not plastic – and are securely mounted in dovetails machined into the slide while others simply snap their sights into position. Three dot (white) sights are standard, and night sights are also available.

Finally, the KPD is made entirely in America by Kimber, the world leader in semi-automatic pistol quality. As with 1911s, Kimber has again redefined what perfection means in a production pistol – this time in a modern design that is surprisingly affordable.





More than any firearm manufactured today, a Kimber rimfire rifle stands above everything else in its category. Both the Kimber 17™, chambered in the new 17 Mach 2, and the Kimber 22™ in the timeless .22 LR adopt the classic features that keep Kimber centerfire rifles in demand. At the same time, their legendary accuracy comes from inside, where a combination of design, quality materials and flawless execution blend together.

A Kimber rimfire action is really a miniature centerfire. The firing pin is actually centered in the bolt body and driven by a powerful spring through an exceptionally short length of travel, reducing lock time for greater accuracy. Equally important, the Kimber design is incredibly strong – so strong that dry fire practice will not cause damage. The receiver is drilled offset from the axis of the bore so the centered firing pin strikes the rim of the cartridge like the finest European target rifles.

As the bolt is operated, the rim of the top cartridge in the flush-fitting five-round magazine slides under the Mauser claw extractor which guides it straight into the tapered match grade chamber in perfect alignment with the bore. Bullet tips are seated into the rifling without distortion as the locking lugs engage the shoulder of the receiver and cam the bolt body the final .100-inch forward into locked position.



Kimber rimfire actions are machined from 4140-class steel, just like Kimber centerfires. Likewise, rimfire barrels are machined from the same quality of barrel blanks and stocks come from the same shipments of walnut and laminate as those used for the big rifles.

While some might say that a Kimber rimfire rifle is over-engineered, little things can make a big difference in performance. Barrels are carefully free-floated their full length to avoid accuracy-robbing pressure. A recoil lug is mounted in a dovetail machined into the front of the receiver, increasing the bedding surface and further securing the action against movement in the stock. For safety as well as security against loss, the magazine release button is recessed into the steel bottom metal. Each model is fitted with a .5-inch recoil pad to prevent slipping in the field or during storage. Kimber even designed a premium set of two-piece scope mounts that blend perfectly with the lines of the receiver and accept most standard rotary/dovetail rings from major manufacturers.

All said and done, a Kimber rimfire rifle has all the features expected from a fine centerfire, including near perfect balance and stock dimensions. They are a pleasure to carry and shoot. They can be owned and displayed with absolute pride.

In keeping with tradition, every Kimber 22 rifle is tested for accuracy. Prior to shipping, each must shoot a five shot, 50-yard group measuring less than .400-inch center-to-center. The actual test target is packaged with every rifle as a testament to its quality and performance, as well as Kimber's long standing commitment to perfection. Kimber rimfire rifles divide handily into two groups. Some are classic sporters with different levels of refinement in finish and materials while others are designed for a specific purpose. Regardless of caliber, each model offers the same level of performance.

The Classic is the cornerstone model. The AA-grade walnut stock is finished with hand-rubbed oil, checkered by hand in a 20 LPI panel pattern and wears a steel grip cap. The 22-inch light sporter barrel also has the custom contour profile. The Custom Classic™ is even more elegant with its AAA-grade walnut, ebony forend tip and 24 LPI wrap-around checkering. The Hunter is a hard-working version of the Classic that cuts no corners in performance. The walnut stock has a tough, clear finish and panel checkering, and the barrel has a traditional straight taper.

The SuperAmerica™ is Kimber's crown jewel, wearing a AAA-grade walnut stock with 24 LPI wrap checkering pattern, ebony forend tip, cheekpiece and a highly polished blue finish. No rimfire is finer. The Classic Varmint™ has a shorter and heavier fluted stainless steel barrel, along with an A-grade hand-finished walnut stock. The Pro Varmint™ is similar to the Classic Varmint, with a laminated gray and black stock plus blackened barrel flutes. Both are ideal for varminters who walk long distances between stands. The SVT™ (Short Varmint/Target) is a serious heavy varmint with an 18.25-inch straight taper fluted stainless steel bull barrel and high comb laminated target stock.

Finally, the HS™ (Hunter Silhouette) is specifically designed for the demanding NRA Rimfire Silhouette Competition and can only be comfortably fired from a standing position.

Each model is available in .22 LR and four are also chambered in 17 Mach 2. A detailed caliber listing is below, and complete specifications begin on page 58. No other brand of rimfire rifle can equal the performance and elegance of a Kimber.



The Kimber Model 84M™ is a true milestone in rifle design, the first ultra lightweight production hunting rifle that retains classic features like a Mauser claw extractor and three-position wing safety. Kimber broke ground by creating an entirely new action around the .308 Win. family of cartridges, one with absolute minimal dimensions. On a scale the results are impressive. Montana models with premium Kevlar/carbon fiber synthetic stocks weigh just 5 pounds, 2 ounces in .308 Win. Classic models with fine walnut came in at 5 pounds, 10 ounces. The biggest payoff was at the range. Accuracy was exceptional, and proper stock design made them a pleasure to shoot.

Comparing a Model 84M with any other brand of short action or lightweight production hunting rifle puts it all in perspective.

Most are built around bulky full-size actions that have been shortened in the middle. Many cut weight the only other way they can – from the end of the barrel. Cutting a barrel short reduces velocity and usually takes a rifle out of balance. Model 84M barrels are always the proper length to maximize performance, and they have near perfect balance. The payoff comes in the field with flatter bullet trajectory and a rifle that goes quickly to target and holds steady, regardless of shooting position.

Like all Kimber rifles, every Model 84M wears a barrel that is machined to match grade standards and then air gauged to prove consistency within .001 inch. Chambers are cut to exacting match grade dimensions, and every bit of this work is done inside the Kimber factory to ensure quality.

While intentions for the Model 84M action centered on big game rifles, it made sense to build varmint rifles on it as well. After all, a lighter rifle is just as important to a varmint hunter walking between stands or calling locations as it is to a big game hunter climbing mountains. While barrels for varmint calibers are generally longer and heavier, models like the Pro Varmint™, Varmint™ and LongMaster Classic™ in 204 Ruger, .223 Rem. or .22-250 Rem. weigh about the same as an average hunting rifle. For serious varmint shooters who like to stay in position until they wear out their welcome at a prairie dog town, Kimber has two heavyweight varminters with bull barrels – the LongMaster VT™ (Varmint/Target) in .22-250 Rem. and the SVT™ (Short Varmint/Target) in .223 Rem.

Model 84M rifles are available with a wide variety of classic stocks. All feature bedding on aluminum pillars and most are also glass

bedded at the recoil lug. Everything from fine walnut to laminated wood to synthetic is offered. The latest additions are Classic Select Grades in AA-grade claro walnut or A-grade French walnut with ebony forend tip.

Sometimes little details make a big difference. All models with wood and laminated stocks have sculpted steel bottom metal with floorplate release button inside the trigger bow. Scalloped two-piece base sets that complement the graceful dimensions of the receiver are available. Sold separately, they accept most standard rotary/dovetail rings.

The Model 84M Pro Varmint is the definitive walking varmint.



Instead of just shortening a standard action and calling it good, Kimber designed the Model 84M action with minimal dimensions specifically for the .308 Win. cartridge family. Kimber saved weight without sacrificing performance.

Model 84M rifles in big game calibers have both pillar bedding and glass bedding for strength and accuracy. Rifles with walnut and laminated stocks feature sculpted steel bottom metal and a floorplate release inside the trigger bow.



They have full-length 24-inch light sporter barrels that wring out every bit of flat-shooting, hard-hitting potential. Walnut-stocked versions weight 6 pounds, 10 ounces. With their premium Kevlar/carbon fiber stocks, Montana models weight just 6 pounds, 3 ounces. Even though they are exceptionally light, properly shaped stocks with straight combs and 1-inch Pachmayr® Decelerator pads greatly diminish felt recoil. A classic version will be available in all five calibers, with traditional features like matte blue and walnut stock. Montana versions with Kimber's premium Kevlar/carbon fiber stock and stainless steel barreled action could well be the toughest all-weather production hunting rifle ever offered. Both magnums will also be offered in SuperAmerica versions – with custom rifle quality for a production rifle price.
