Light, fast handling and great value have always been the hallmarks of Franchi shotguns. With new alloys and computer controlled machinery, Franchi remains on the cutting edge and no shotgun exemplifies the 21st Century Franchi more than the I-12 semi-auto. "I" for Inertia Driven™: Franchi has harnessed the power of inertia in a design that is super dependable and versatile enough to digest everything from light field loads to the heaviest 3" magnums. Beautifully styled, the I-12 is stocked with black synthetic, two patterns of Advantage® camo or luxurious satin finished walnut.

Added to the I-12 line for 2006 is the new White Gold. Its nickel receiver is the engraver's canvas and is beautifully adorned with exquisite scenes of animated wildlife, as elegantly composed as a fine painting. The game birds are inlaid with white gold and look as though they could take flight from this I-12's receiver. The White Gold features select grade walnut with plenty of dramatic figure to complement the luxury of the metal work.

Of course there's a lot more from Franchi in 2006. The all-new Renaissance series of over/under shotguns incorporate cutting edge technology in super-light alloys and recoil absorbing gel synthetics. The three grades are embellished with fine engraving from classic game scenes to elaborate motifs with gold filling. The wood is the highest grade of walnut and traditionally oil finished. It's all combined with gorgeous Italian design adding yet another sophisticated masterpiece to the Franchi line. The Renaissance is for the shooter who wants a combination of Franchi technical leadership and the kind of decorative mastery associated with Italy since the Renaissance.



NEWTON'S FIRST LAW – THE LAW OF INERTIA:

“An object at rest tends to stay at rest and an object in motion tends to stay in motion with the same speed and in the same direction unless acted upon by an unbalanced force.”

SIR ISAAC NEWTON

“Inertia Driven” is the heart of the Franchi family of semi-automatic firearms and relies upon one of the basic laws of physics: The Law of Inertia. In physics the Law of Inertia states that an object at rest tends to stay at rest; that object, in the Inertia Driven™ system, is the free-floating bolt. When the gun is fired all of the fixed parts of the gun are propelled rearward by the gun's recoil. In the Inertia Driven™ system, all of the gun parts are fixed except one — the free-floating bolt. Between the free-floating bolt and the rotary locking head is a short, very stiff inertia spring. When the gun fires, the bolt briefly holds its position as the fixed parts move to the rear, causing the inertia spring to be compressed. As the shot charge leaves the barrel and the rearward force of the gun diminishes, the compressed inertia spring throws the bolt rearward with sufficient force to unlock the rotating bolt head, eject the spent shell and recock the hammer. The recoil spring then returns the bolt, which travels forward picking up and chambering another shell and locking the rotating head back into place. With the Inertia Driven™ system, the bolt weight and inertia spring power are sufficient to cycle light loads and they have no choice but to function on all heavier loads — it's the law of physics.

INERTIA SYSTEM



STEP 1
CHAMBERING

As the bolt assembly moves into battery, the locking head pin moves along a curved track in the bolt body to rotate the steel bolt head into engagement with the steel barrel extension. The cartridge drop lever is down, indicating the gun is cocked.



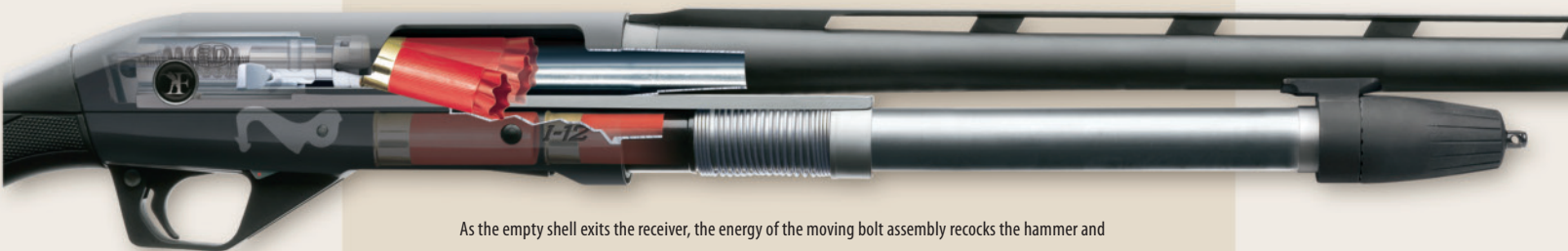
STEP 2
FIRING

When the trigger is pulled, the gun fires and every part of the shotgun except the bolt body moves rearward. The curved track in the bolt body, which is moving forward relative to the rest of the gun, presses against the locking head pin, turning the bolt head even tighter into the barrel extension. At the same time, the inertia spring is compressed between bolt head and body. The cartridge drop lever moves up, allowing a shell to move from the magazine to the carrier.



STEP 3
RECOIL

Near the end of the recoil cycle, chamber pressure drops to a safe level and the gun's rearward motion slows. The heavy inertia spring then thrusts the bolt assembly rearward, unlocking the rotating bolt head, extracting the spent shell from the chamber and pulling it against the ejector.



STEP 4
EJECTION

As the empty shell exits the receiver, the energy of the moving bolt assembly recocks the hammer and compresses the recoil spring on the magazine tube. The recoil spring then thrusts the bolt assembly forward, lifting the oncoming shell into position and chambering a fresh cartridge. The gun is ready to fire again... in a fraction of a second!

The old duck club members suspiciously checked out your new Franchi I-12 when you climbed down into the tank blind. They all shot gas operated semi-autos; one old guy even named his "Old Faithful." You smiled to yourself knowing that your I-12 was Inertia Driven™ and on a day like that, when it was spitting snow and rain you didn't have to worry about burnt powder sludge gumming up your gun's action.

The first big bunch of "red legs" came over high, eyed the spread and came back around. One of the old guys worked them just right; giving them soft feeding chuckles, luring the ducks lower. They set their wings and committed over the flooded corn. One of the old guys threw down the front of the blind and growled "take 'em." As the I-12 touched your shoulder, you sent a load of 3-inch No. 2s at a big green head, he shuddered and you hit him again. You swung on another drake that was climbing out and dumped him too. Watching the last mallard fall, you realize you were the only one still shooting.

The old gas guns had only fired twice before jamming.

"Old Faithful" must mean that two out of three ain't bad.

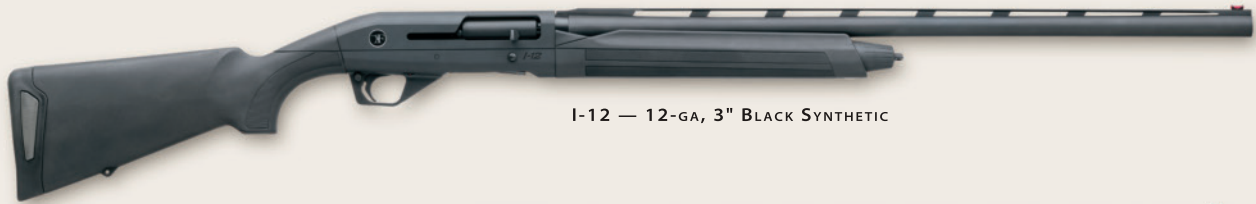

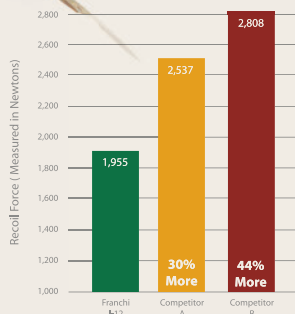


The I-12 magazine cap complements the slender, low profile design of the new semi-auto. Along with sleek styling, the I-12's magazine cap is ridged to aid your grip, with or without a glove. The magazine cap comes with a sling swivel stud installed as a standard feature.



The I-12's recoil pad is unique in both form and function. A two part design with a special gel insert, the I-12's recoil pad holds its shape during firing and then deeply compresses during recoil, soaking up the kick and spreading recoil energy over a wider area of the shooter's shoulder.

The I-12's Twin Shock Absorber™ gel-insert was put through a series of tests to measure felt recoil. The Franchi I-12 with its TSA gel-insert recoil pad has up to 44% less recoil than the competition.

FEATURES

The Franchi I-12 is Inertia Driven™ and does not rely on gas valves or pistons. The heart of the inertia system is simplicity itself – a free floating bolt compressing an inertia spring as the gun recoils, creating power that works the action.

With none of the bulky gas cylinders and associated hardware under the fore-end, the Inertia Driven™ I-12 has a slender, low profile fore-end that better fits the shooter's hand and makes for faster handling.

Opening day of the South Dakota

pheasant season should be a national holiday by your way of thinking. It's turned into a tradition, a couple of the guys flying in, the rest driving. Beautifully accented with white gold game birds on a satin nickel receiver, this new Franchi incorporates all of the good looks, light weight and fast-handling features that Franchi is known for, with the World-class dependability of an Inertia Driven™ operating system.

The White Gold is not only slender, it's perfectly balanced and like all Franchis, the White Gold is light weight; tipping the scales within a few ounces of seven and a half pounds.

To tame recoil, Franchi developed a two-part recoil pad with a special gel insert called the Twin Shock Absorber™. The pad holds its shape during firing, before the gel insert allows the pad to deeply compress, soaking up recoil energy and spreading the kick over the widest area possible. Felt recoil is reduced by as much as 43%.

The new White Gold is one of the prettiest semi-automatic shotguns ever built, with standard features such as AA figured walnut with a classic oil finish, cut checkering and a satin nickel receiver beautifully accented with white gold game birds.

It's the toughest station on the course:

"Darting Doves" – a true pair, through the trees, left to right. You change extended choke tubes as you watch the targets make fools out of your friends.

Sporting clays is speed and timing; you need to take out the first target before the big tree; it's a snap shot, but there's no other way. The Raptor balances naturally as you focus your thoughts, the time is now; you call "pull."

The pair cuts knife blade thin through the trees, but everything's on autopilot. The Raptor comes to your shoulder smoothly as you swing. The tapered rib passes in front of the lead target, you touch the trigger and there's a cloud of dust just before the tree. The recoil is soft, the porting keeps the barrel down and you nail the second clay on the other side with room to spare. The second pair falls the same; the third pair you grind extra-fine.

As you move to the next station, your friends sneak glances at the satin nickel receiver and figured walnut of your Franchi Raptor. It's good to have style, and it's great to be at the top of your game.

The sunflower fields, three hours south of the border, are a short drive on Mexican back roads. The sun is just cracking the horizon when you pile out, load your guide up with a case of 28-ga. ammo and pull out your Franchi 48 AL. You set up just in front of the mesquite trees where the doves roost. As you load four in the magazine and one in the chamber, you hear a shot as the first whitewing doves make their appearance. Within thirty minutes the gunfire is constant and whitewings are darting past you right over the trees. It's snap shooting; lighting fast and nonstop. You catch one on a sharp right angle, get a double coming right at you, swing on another pair high and pick up an easy single coming across the field, then it's time to reload.

As you reload, you can't help but smile thinking about your buddies beating themselves to death with eight-pound 12-gauges. They'll all be sore-shouldered and early to bed, but you're shooting a gun that weighs just a hair over 5 pounds and hardly kicks at all...maybe you'll try a little salsa dancing after dinner tonight.

A recoiling barrel is the sure sign of a long-recoil autoloader design. On firing, bolt and barrel travel rearward together. As pressure inside the barrel drops, they unlock, and the barrel returns forward under spring pressure. The bolt follows, picking up a fresh shell on its way. When it returns to battery, another shot can be fired immediately.
