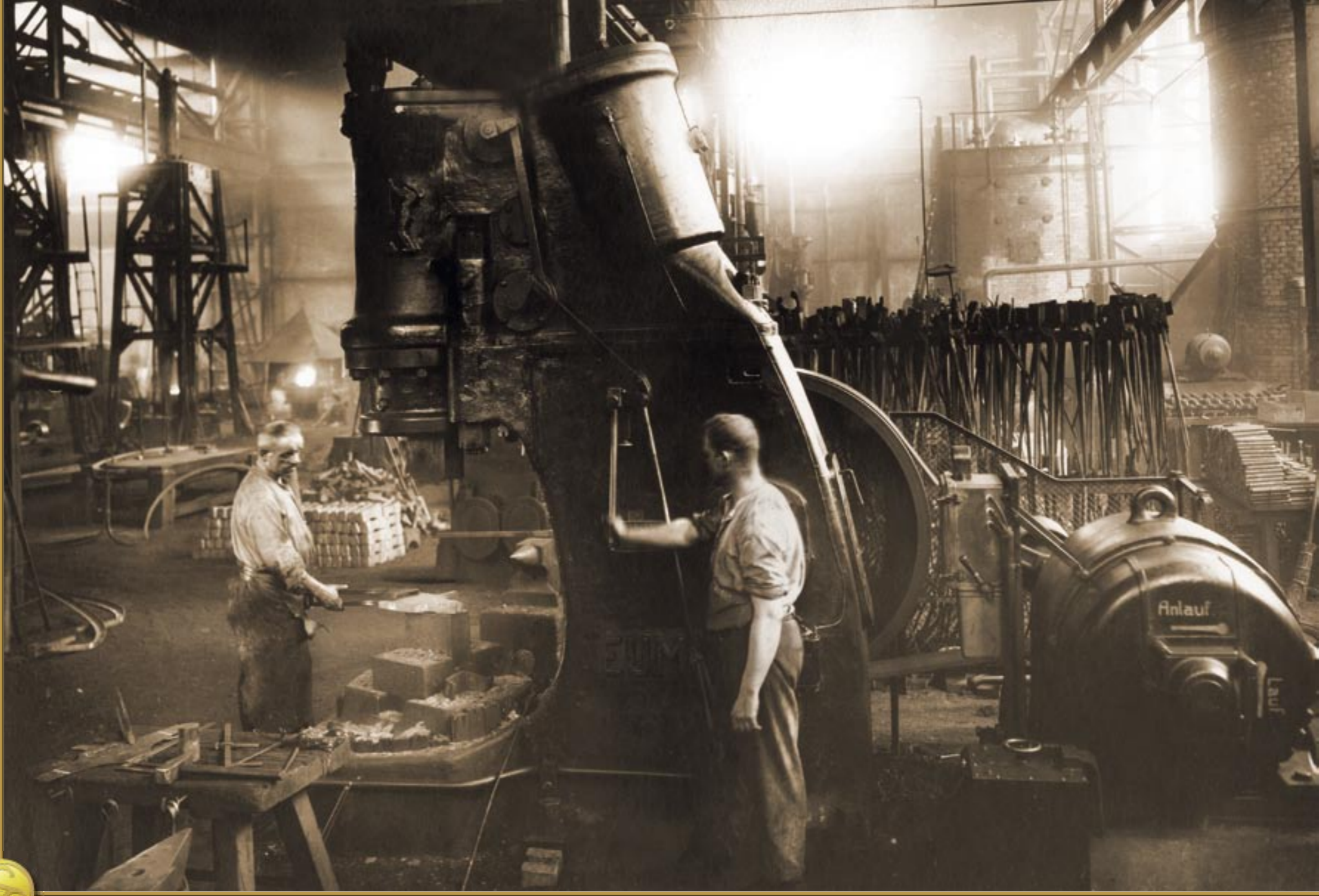

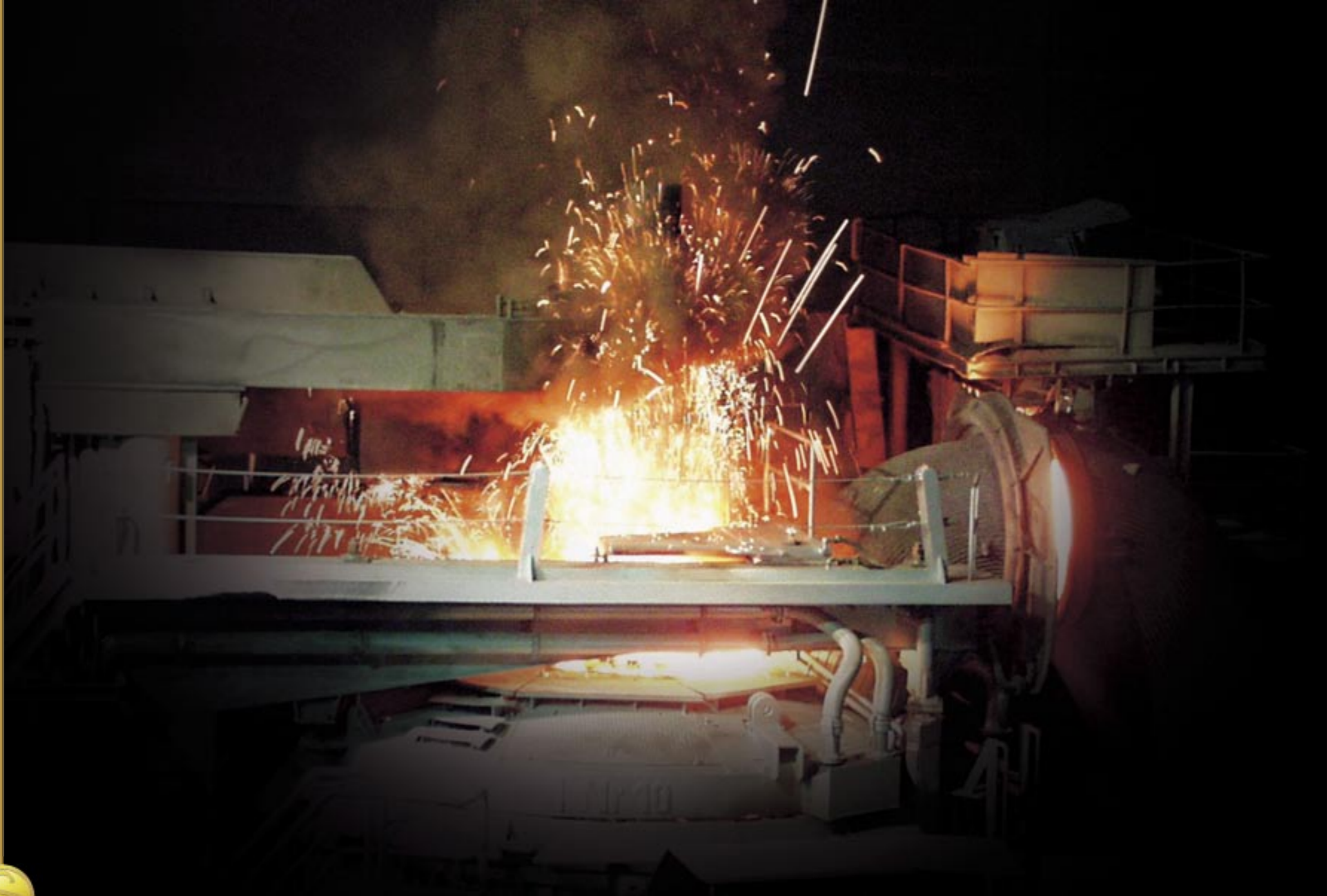

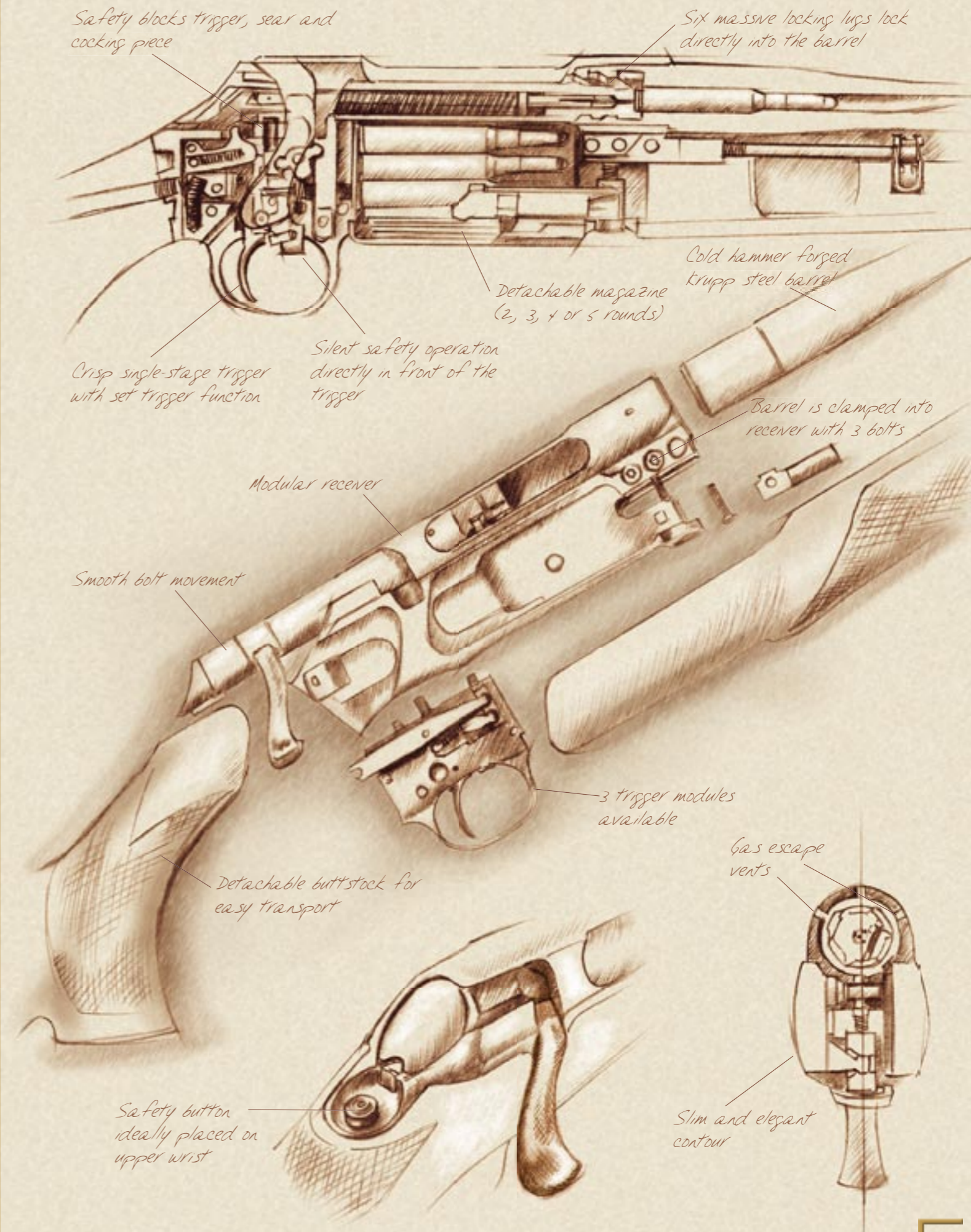

Perfection in Detail

With more than 330,000 guns sold worldwide, SAUER is the largest German manufacturer of bolt action rifles in the post-war era. This experience and success propels the company towards new innovations and consequently focusing on the needs of the hunter. That is how the SAUER 202 came to be – a bolt action rifle in form, function, technology and accuracy which has no rival.

- At the heart of the rifle is the receiver milled from one solid block of metal. All other components are modular. This principle is the prerequisite for long-term performance and an enormous flexibility.
- The Krupp steel barrel is developed in a laborious process that includes honing, cold hammer forging, stress relieving, turning and finishing. This process is used for both hunting guns and target rifles, and is the key to SAUER's legendary precision.
- Barrels of the same calibre family may be easily interchanged. Always having the same handling and balance guarantee your hunting success.
- Six massive lugs lock the bolt directly into the barrel to resist the entire force of the shot. This special design enables the hunter to choose either steel or light metal receivers. This way, weight and balance are controlled at the optimal point: The middle of the gun.
- The bolt opens smoothly with a bolt lift of only 60°. The set trigger automatically unsets itself when the bolt handle is lifted.
- The safety follows a proven concept: "One button – one function!" You can either see or feel the indicator on the upper wrist to verify that the rifle is on "Safe". The safety releases easily and silently just in front of the trigger. You will feel and sense the advantages of this safety action, but you will never hear them, because the mechanism works completely noiselessly.
- The combination single-stage trigger with adjustable set trigger function offers perfect performance in every situation. No matter what trigger function you choose, the shot will break like glass.
- The warp-free stock is of two piece construction and has no load-bearing function. This way, the fanciest woods may be used without affecting the precision or stability of the rifle.
- The S 202 is available in a dedicated left-handed version (action and stock) because a strong rifle belongs on the hunter's strong side.

“My favourite place is here, at the peak. You can see the Rhine and the vineyards – my hunting ground is my home. Of course, my impressions from hunting trips around the world are unforgettable. Kazakhstan, Zimbabwe, Alaska, Eastern Europe – hunting in unknown territory is both alluring and challenging. I can vividly remember how much I suffered during the ibex hunt in the Altai Mountains. My guide set a breakneck speed. He jumped through rocks and boulders with the agility of a chamois, and galloped up the steepest hills seemingly immune to the dizzying effects of altitude. He then usually whistled a cheerful melody that made you think there was no need for him to breathe at all. I followed, my thoughts somewhere between “this is crazy” and “don’t lose your footing!” In the end, it is the hunt that compensated for all these sorrows. Now a colossal trophy adorns my hunting room and evokes time and again the gruesomely beautiful memories of that awful ascent.

If I had to make a choice, I would not exchange my hunting lot for any adventure in the world. Every corner here holds a memorable story worth telling. Simply speaking, I am deeply rooted here. Something I would also never want

to miss is the hunting with friends. Debating the age of the old buck in the vineyard. Guessing the trophy size of the stag down at the river. Analyzing our weapons and the performances of the dogs. Reliving the perfect shots. Planning the next hunt.

After more than 40 years as a hunter, I have had a lifetime of experience with guns. As a trainer of junior hunters, I observe novices doing their first exercises and teach them how to refine their skill and dexterity in using a rifle, shotgun or handgun. As a trainer for drive hunting and long-range shooting I also know when shooter and gun simply do not match. As an active marksman I understand that success depends on having the right equipment. I attach great importance to excellent quality, smooth handling and, of course, accuracy. Moreover, I expect variety because every hunter is an individual: Male or female, tall or short, chubby or slim, right- or left-hander. We hunt in many ways, from the lowlands to the mountains. My own hunting rifle as well as the rifles that I recommend in my courses must meet all expectations.”



Max Wiegand has hunted in a wide variety of terrain and is familiar with all aspects of hunting. Today he looks back on more than 40 years as an active hunter, cherishing his diverse range of experiences as well as his perennial hunts with friends. In his opinion, after years as an instructor, a proper rifle is a major ingredient to success.

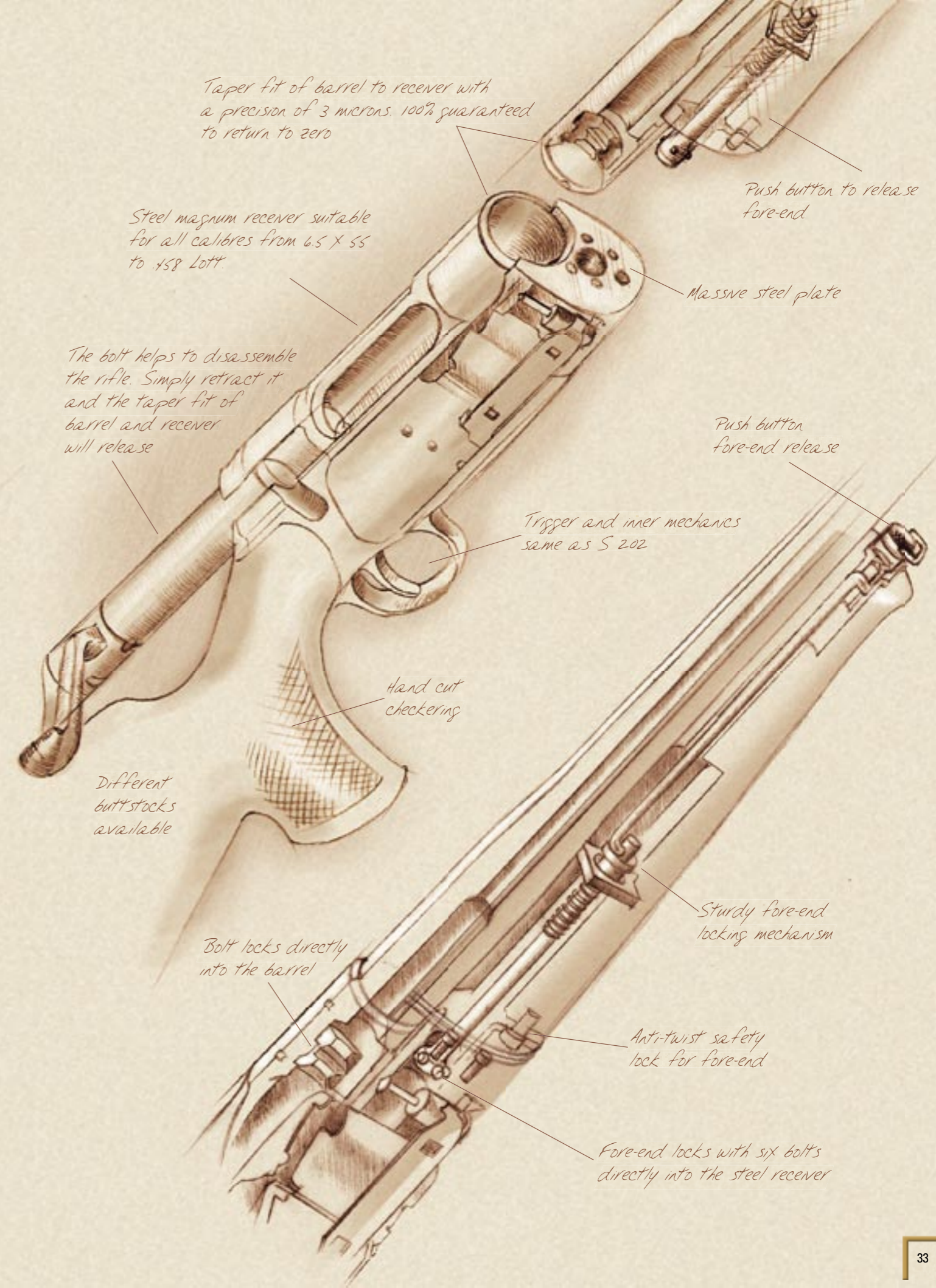

- Based on the SAUER 202 design, the receiver is the supporting element of the rifle. Immune from stock bedding issues, the action practically supports itself.
- The barrel and receiver are connected by a snug-fitting cone plug that is free of play and compensates for wear. The state-of-the-art manufacturing process ensures minimum tolerances and maximum precision.
- Six lugs lock the bolt directly in the barrel. This guarantees perfect headspace after every disassembly and assembly and prevents wear and tear at the plug connecting barrel and receiver.
- With the press of a button, six lugs lock the fore-end directly into the steel receiver.

The Essence of Hunting



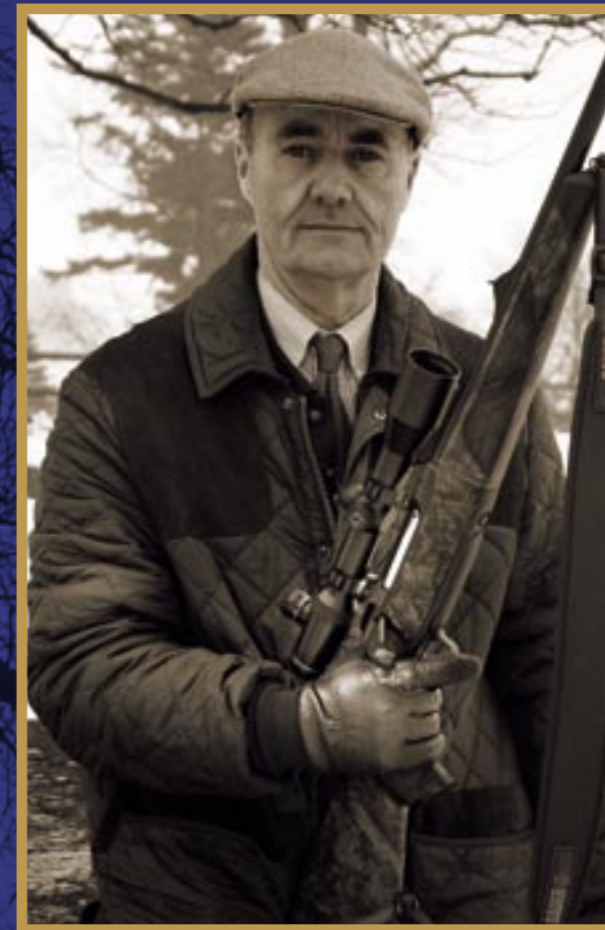
Dick von Blixen-Finecke, passionate hunter on home and foreign paths. His rifle is an S 202 Take Down in different calibres.

“On one of my trips to Africa I went after buffalo in Tanzania. Even though I knew that the area I would hunt in was wetland wilderness, I didn't expect to be in the middle of it so soon after my arrival. When airplanes and jeeps could not transport us any further, there were only two ways to get to the camp and that was by a mokoro or by foot. The mokoro is a dugout canoe made from a straight tree trunk and since it can move very quietly through shallow waters it was perfect transportation for my destination. I figured I would get enough opportunity for a foot-march during my hunt, so I jumped in the mokoro and the boatman, using a long pole, softly pushed the canoe into the looping channels. We reached camp after one and a half hours and immediately started to get our gear ready for an early start the next day.

As is typical for swamps, the vegetation was lush and the landscape a labyrinth of water, grassy flood plains and small bush islands. We stalked both by canoe and by foot, often in water. Since the buffalo often stay in the open plains, close to water and mud, we also had to crawl to be able to come close enough without being spotted. If we were spotted, one of two things would happen: The herd would either attack us or flee. Either alternative was not attractive.

After a couple of days stalking with nothing but marshland in sight, suddenly a single, mud-caked bull with massive bosses appeared in a small open plain. He saw us the same moment I pulled the trigger. Even though the first shot should have taken him down, his adrenaline kept him up. The thick grass and bushes around us were no place I wanted to go stalking for a wounded buffalo, so I quickly followed up with a second shot. Still fighting furiously, the bull turned toward me and fixed me with a dark stare. The dust from his movements almost concealed him completely and the struggle made large mud-cakes fall off his already lion-scarred body. My heart was pounding and sweat from the tension and the gazing sun stung in my eyes as I stared through the sight. Finally, the third shot brought this great old Nyati to the ground.

That night, as I sat outside my tent, the whole scene kept repeating itself in my head. The smoke from the open campfire almost kept the mosquitoes away as I silently cleaned my rifle. I thought of my ancestors who sat here before me, in another time and another world, perhaps in different attire and with different equipment, yet with the same desire for the grand adventure, the True Hunt, the Essence of it all.”

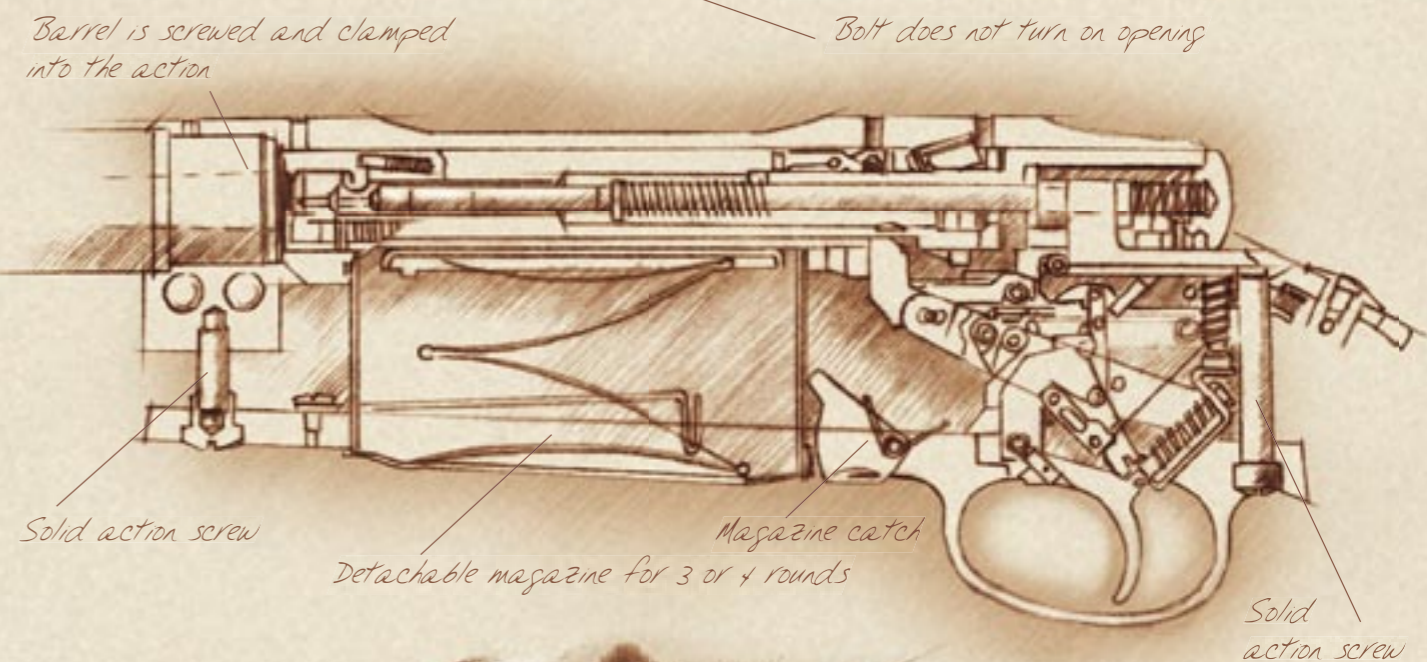
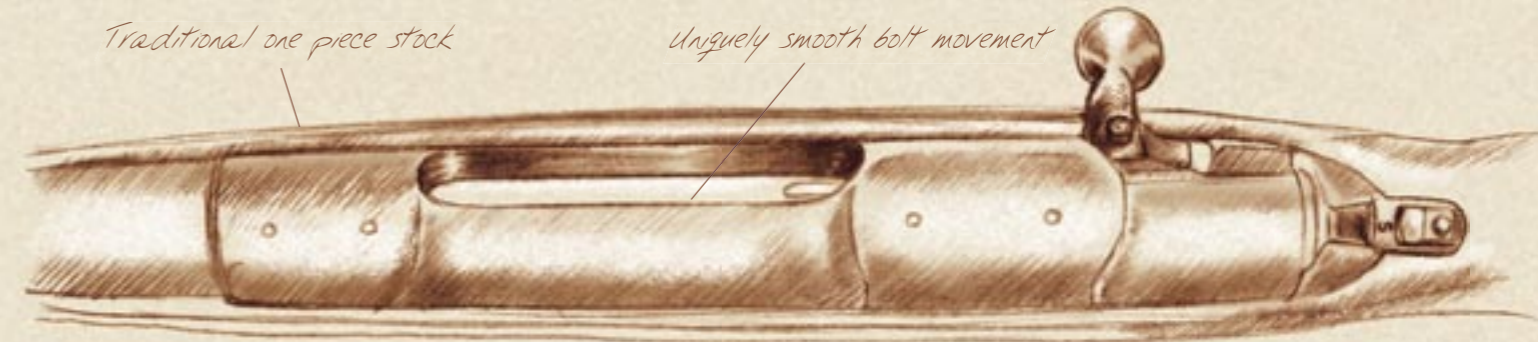

The Traditions of Hunting and Craftsmanship

Moritz Prince to Oettingen-Wallerstein, landowner, farmer, forester, hunter and target shooter. Member of the Presidium in the Bavarian Hunting Association. Duties include responsibility for marksmanship, shooting ranges and continuing education of shooting instructors. His rifle is a Sauer 90 Elegance in .30-06.



“The hunt is deeply rooted in the history of humanity, originating within and still part of every society. Through the millennia, the most diverse cultures of the world have developed traditions that reflect the hunter’s deep reverence for the creatures of the chase. Today, it is the mission of the hunter to preserve these values while at the same time putting his modern knowledge of wildlife biology to best use. Prudent game management, proactive wildlife preservation and ensuring huntable populations for the future are the cornerstones of our efforts.

These often abstract objectives are nonetheless obvious in the daily life of the hunter: In the routine patrol through the woodlot, the reforestation of a clear-cut or the reestablishment of grazing crops and cover, we are also active outdoorsmen even when we are not actually “hunting”. It is this dedication that makes us what we are: Hunters working to the principles of sowing and reaping, preservation and use. These principles have, despite the encroachments of urbanization and industrialization, resulted in the maintenance of a many-faceted diversity of animals. Without our long-standing traditional respect for game, this would have been impossible.

It is when the time for the game harvest has arrived that not only attitude but also equipment plays an important role. Respect for the game obliges us to use a highly accurate rifle possessing perfect reliability and the best possible optics. After all, once the prey has been chosen and identified, the ultimate objec-

tive is the clean shot. And, as in centuries past, the hunting gun is much more than a mere tool. It is an expression of how one hunts and what the hunter values most. My rifle must complement my own hunting attitude: It must possess functionality and accuracy of the highest order. Also, I simply need to feel the personal craftsmanship of the expert gunmaker in my hands. The fact that one man has invested his knowledge and skill to give my gun the properties that I value in the hunting field is for me the perfect harmony of two grand traditions – hunting and gunmaking. When everything works as smooth as silk, glides silently in operation and, in other words, “fits”, then I am happy and can concentrate on my hunting with all the passion I bring to it without the distractions caused by inferior equipment.

My most recent drive hunt: The firebreak was fairly narrow but the man-high natural spruce blind made up for it. It didn’t take much time before the sharp cries of the hounds filled the air. The singing of the pack came closer and closer and I knew right then where the boar would come through the break. Suddenly, they shot through! At the forefront was a hefty sow, behind her a few shoats and piglets. I drew a bead on one of the shoats and the bullet found its mark. While I worked the action, the reticle found the vitals of another. He, too, rolled to the shot. And, as quickly as they came, so, too, were they gone. I then put the rifle on “Safe”, changed magazines and picked up the empty cases. Settling down to wait for the next chance, I was alert yet quiet, my heart full with what I had just experienced.”

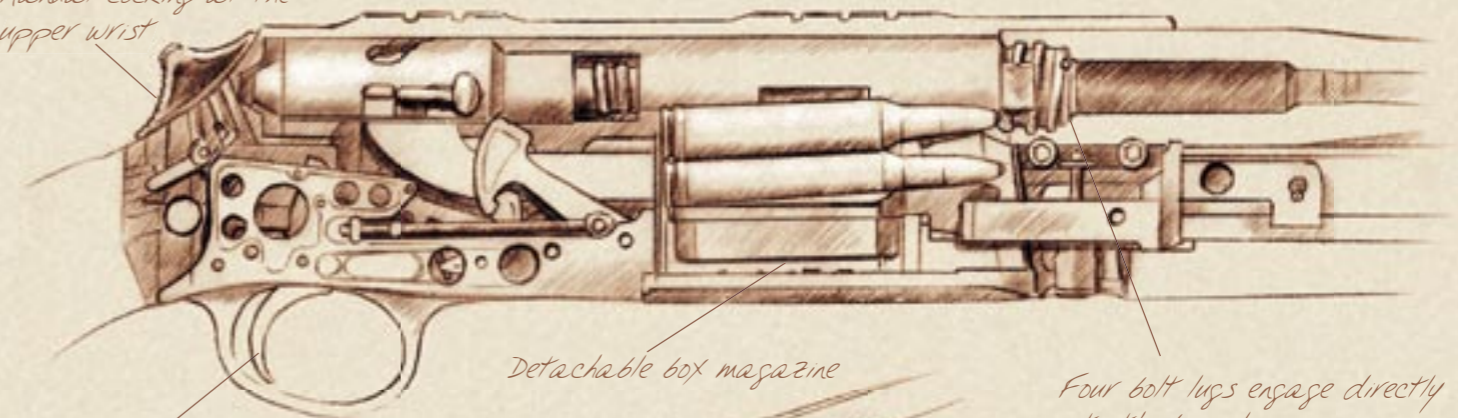

- A receiver milled from a solid block of metal is at its foundation. All other component parts are of modular design.
- The manual cocking feature on the upper wrist provides a premium on safety in any situation. All manual operations for loading, unloading and magazine removal as well as closing or opening the breech may be performed while the gun is decocked.
- The "IntraLock" firing pin safety engages automatically if the breech is not 100% in battery.
- Soldered or screwed-on barrel blocks are not necessary for gas management. Additionally, the automatic loading sequence cannot influence barrel vibrations since the forward part of the barrel is fully free-floating. The S 303 has inherited the accuracy for which SAUER is famous.
- The single-stage trigger sets new standards in its class. Creep is minimal and the shot breaks at 1,300 g like glass. With this unparalleled performance, the S 303 does as well from the blind as from the stand.
- The proprietary "isi-Mount" is perfectly tailored to the needs of today's hunter. With a 100% repeatable point of impact after removal, it puts the scope lower than ever before and only two motions are needed to adjust the eye relief by 1 cm.
- The contrasting open sights consist of a triangular yellow rear blade and a red front bead which instinctively lead the eye to the target. The front sight is click-adjustable for windage and elevation. The optional Battue rib with its long sight line helps you make those tough snap shots.
- Snow, rain, cold and a pile of thorns – "NITROBOND X" is the new steel surface treatment that scoffs at the elements. Two elaborate plasma treatments ensure uncompromising protection against rust and scratching.

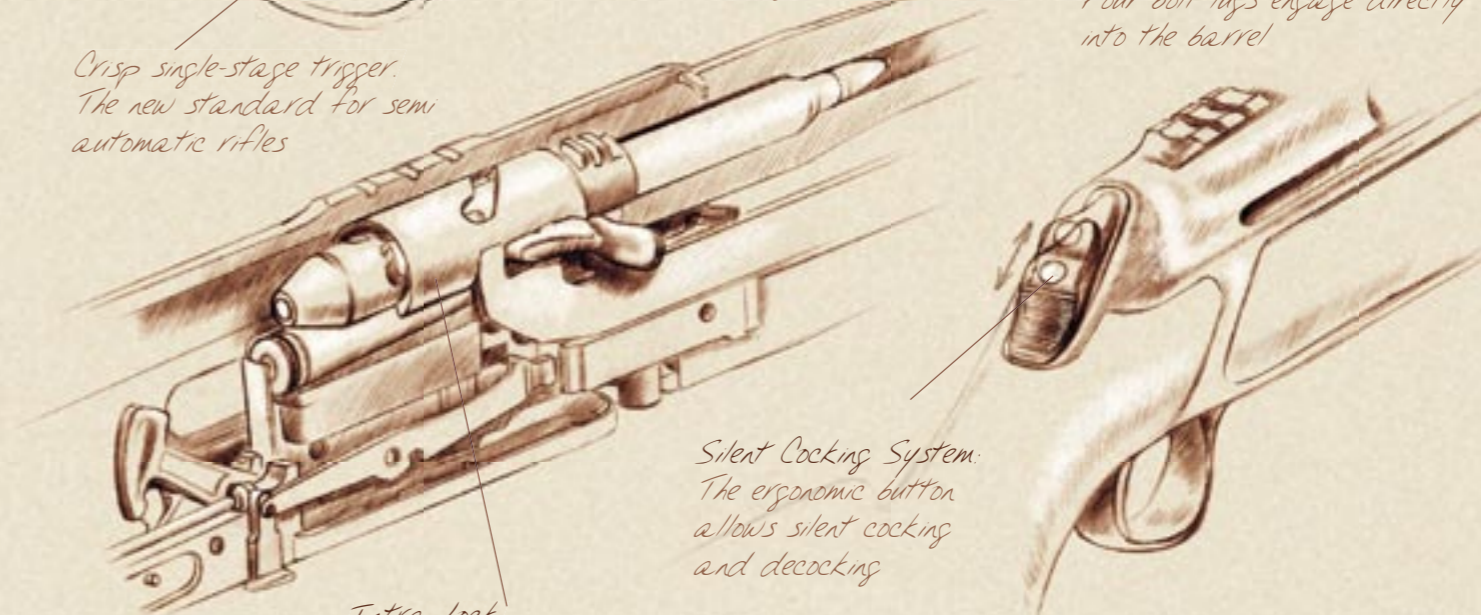

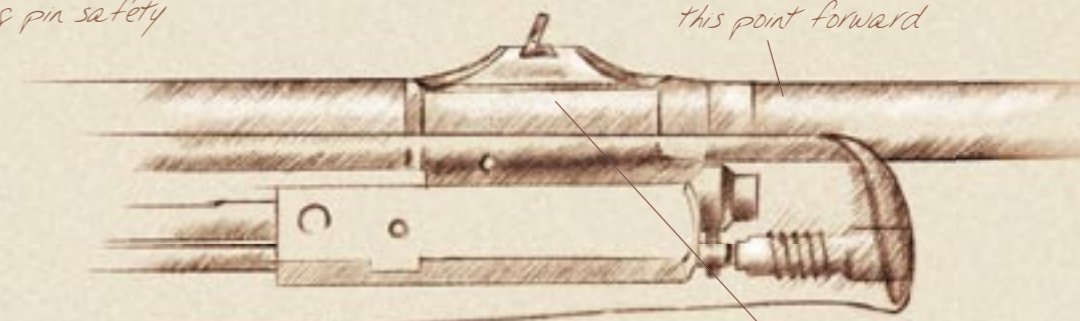

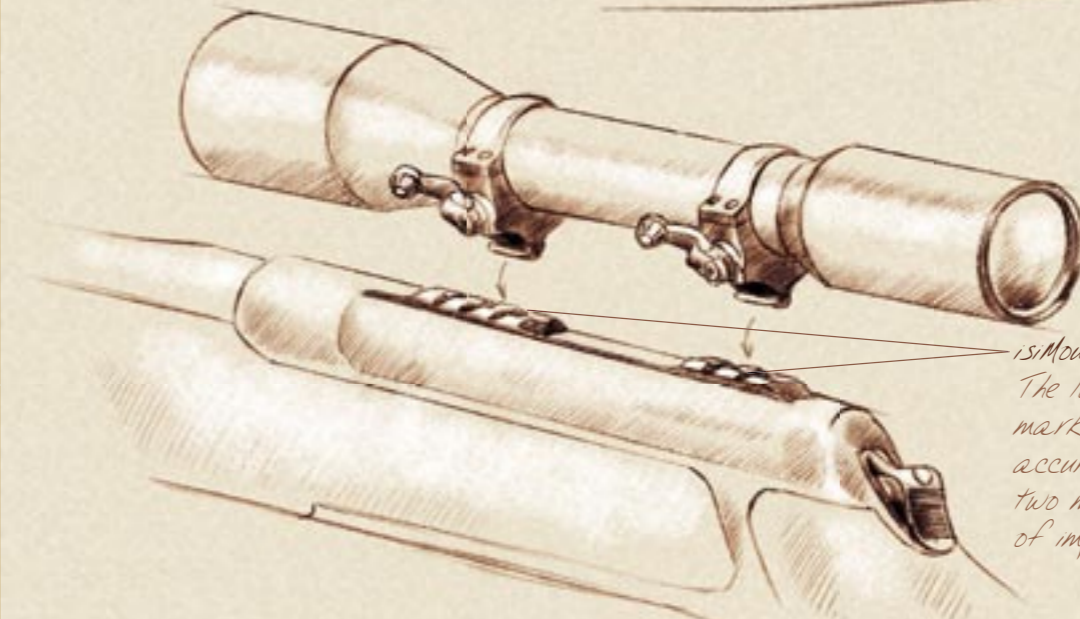

The S 303 Semi Automatic Rifle's construction offers enormous advantages to the shooter. After once firing, the hunter must not release his grip on the gun to reload for the next shot.

“The drive hunt is without a doubt the sport of kings. It is the revered tradition of the group hunt with all the elements of skilful woodcraft and organization combined. For me, the difference in such a hunt is the “How?” and not the “How much?” The safe progress of the hunt without incident shows that the Hunting Master and his team have correctly planned and organized the event. That the game is merely on the move and not stampeding in panic proves the worth of the dogs and beaters. Now it is only up to the shooter to provide a bag that in size, constitution and quality is worth the effort brought.

As Hunting Master of my own game lands as well as an invited guest shooter elsewhere, it is my uppermost priority that the game be cleanly brought to bag in a sportsmanlike manner. Good preparation and the correct equipment are for me an important prerequisite to a successful hunt. My drive hunt rifle must allow me to react safely and instinctively. And when it comes down to it, I expect the balance of a shotgun, the precision of a bolt action and the quick second shot of a double rifle. I also value a unique design that reflects my own ideas on what a hunting gun should look like. My hunting rifle has thoroughly classic styling and is my visible statement on our ways and traditions.”

“At the moment the shot breaks, countless bits of information flood the shooter's senses. The flash sight picture, the game's reaction to the shot, the recoil, the whip, the report, etc. etc. etc. In this storm of visual and acoustic input, the shooter must make further decisions in a fraction of a second and, above all, be prepared to carry them out. Many chances are missed and the saving repeat shot must stay in the barrel simply because the shooter has to manually reload. Once he is back up and again ready to shoot, the game has either disappeared or the distance and angle make the shot impossible.

That is why I have for years carried a semi automatic rifle fore-end when quick shooting is required. Less recoil and whip allow me to “see through the fire” with certainty and determine whether the game has been mortally wounded. Without having to stop my swing or change my grip, a second or third round is immediately available.

Then I can react instantly to either put down a piece already hit or to take on another still in range. Now, all these advantages are finally combined into a safe and beautiful hunting rifle.”
