(2) **Trigger block.** This device prevents the trigger from being pulled until the lever is closed. (3) **Half cock hammer position.** This is the traditional lever action hammer safety position. (4) **Hammer block safety.** When engaged, it prevents the hammer from striking the firing pin, even if the trigger is pulled.
